NOTICE OF DECISION OF THE CABINET MEMBER FOR WASTE, RECYCLING and CLEANSING

Pursuant to the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012, Regulation 13(1) and Section 9F (4) of the Local Government Act 2000

Decision Notice Not Exempt under Part 1 of Schedule 12A to the Local Government Act 1972.

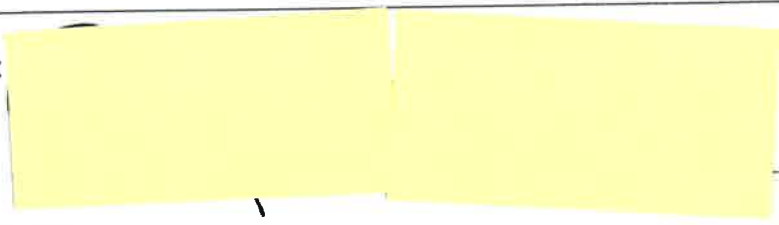
Authority to enter into a contract for the disposal of the Council's existing refuse fleet and associated plant and equipment.

Decision	The Cabinet Member for Waste, Recycling and Cleansing is requested to authorise the council to enter into a contract for the disposal of the council's existing refuse fleet
Reason for Decision	Contract procedure rule 4f.9 of the council's constitution requires individual Cabinet Members to authorise the conclusion of contracts with a value in excess of £100,000. A pre-sale estimate of the council's side loader fleet and plant is likely to be in excess of £100,000.
Possible alternatives considered but rejected	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. E-Bay – rejected as there would be no guarantee that specialist interested parties, both national and international, would be captured. This approach would also require the continued storage of the fleet and plant at additional cost in the light of the expiry of time limited planning permissions for vehicle and plant storage at Hop Oast park and ride car park and at Britannia Crest premises, Langhurstwood Road. 2. Advertise for sale – rejected for the same reasons above and would additionally incur significant advertising costs with no guarantee of sufficient third party interest to maximise returns.
