Given these factors, it is important that the Council has a clear vision of its sport and physical activity priorities and how these can be achieved.</p> |
| A8 | Economic Development Strategy | <p>RESOLVED</p> <p>That the Horsham District Economic Strategy be approved.</p> <p>REASON</p> <p>Approval of the Economic Strategy ensures that the priorities and actions are endorsed by the Council as a whole. It will be a visible document that demonstrates to businesses and residents, the commitment to securing economic growth for the District.</p> |
