My only concern is the potential for advise noise impacts. The most likely source of noise to neighbouring residential properties is from the funfair and the music stage. I would welcome further information on the measures to limit noise from the funfair and the music stage.

Section 10.7 of the EMP states that:

"Although there are PA sound systems at the event, they are there for localised sound and it is not anticipated that there will be any sound complaints particularly as the sound systems will be switched off by 21.30hrs."

Further information on the speaker systems and predicted music noise levels should be provided.
